(Made under Section 65)

THE ANIMAL DISEASES (ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS MOVEMENT CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2018

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Animals and Animal Products Movement Control) (Amendment) Regulations, 2018 and shall be read as one with the Animal Diseases (Animals and Animal Products Movement Control) (Amendment) Regulations, 2013 herein after referred to as the "Principal Regulations".

Amendment of Thirteenth Schedule

THE ANIMAL DISEASES ACT (CAP. 156)

REGULATIONS

Made under Section 65

THE ANIMAL DISEASES (LIVESTOCK MARKETS) REGULATIONS, 2018

Citation

1. These Regulation may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Livestock Markets) Regulations, 2018 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on such date, as the Minister may by Notice, appoint in the *Gazzete*.

Application

2. These Regulations shall apply throughout Mainland Tanzania.

Interpretation

3. In these Regulations:

"Animal" means any vertebrate or invertebrate other than human being;

"Border Market" means a place declared to be a livestock market and which is situated along the borders of Tanzania and the power for control of which is vested in the Central Government.

"disposition" means the exchange of animal at the market for value;

"Market Master" means a person appointed to be the supervisor and over-all controller of the market in which is animals are disposed of;

"Livestock" means any domesticated animal and includes cattle, water buffalo, sheep, goat, pig, dog, cat, donkey, chicken and game;

"Secondary Market" means a place declared to be a livestock market and which is situated on Mainland Tanzania and the power for control of which is vested in the Central Government.

Declaration of Primary, Secondary and Border Markets

4.-(1) All places designated to be livestock markets and which are under the control of the local government authorities approved by the District Veterinary Officer or such other officer as may be designated for such purposes are hereby declared to be Primary Markets.

	(2) The places specified in the First Schedule to these Regulations are hereby declared to be Secondary and Border Markets respectively.
Disposition of livestock at Markets	5. (1) Any person being the owner, in charge or is otherwise in custody of an animal and moved such animal under a permit to the market shall dispose off any animal at the markets specified in the First Schedule to these Regulations.
	(2) Any person who disposes of an animal contrary to these Regulations commits an offence and is liable upon conviction to a fine of five hundred thousand or to imprisonment for a term of twelve month or to both.
Prohibition of purchase of livestock elsewhere	6. A person shall not purchase livestock at a place other than at the markets specified in Regulation 4 (1) and those in the First Schedule to these Regulations.
Opening of markets	7. All markets shall be open to the public and no person shall trade in the market or at any place whatsoever except during such days, at such places and times as shall have been so prescribed by the Market Master.
Use of weighing scale	8. (1) All designated livestock market shall use weighing scale as the basis for determining disposal price of respective livestock animal (2) It shall be an obligation of the owner of the livestock market to put in place the weighing scale
Observance of hygiene in the markets	9. (1) Every person using or present at a market shall obey all reasonable directives given by the Market Master for the purposes of preserving cleanliness, order and regularity in the market and for facilitating the transaction of business at the market.
	(2) The Market Master may order the removal from the market of any person who fails to obey and such directives including directives not to loiter, cause any disturbance or commit any nuisance or doing any act which in the opinion of the Market Master interferes or is likely to interfere with smooth operations of livestock market.
Fees payable for disposition of livestock	10. (1) The fees specified in the Second Schedule to the Regulations shall become due and payable upon disposition of an animal at the market as well as for the movement of such animal from one place to another place. (2) The fees payable pursuant to sub-regulation (1) shall include fees
0	payable in respect of itinerant and trade stock grazing, movement permit fees and stock route fees.
	(3) Any person who contravenes these Regulations commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine of five hundred thousand shillings.
